Le Bistrot du Paradou is not just a place to go to for lunch. It is an institution we have frequented since 1986, thanks to a restaurant review in the International Herald Tribune by Patricia Wells who

is a member of La Table des Amis de Provence along with her husband Walter.

It has achieved near legendary status over the years as the place for informal, bistro-style cooking in the Alpilles area. Celebrities, locals, affluent second home owners and holiday makers all flock here.

Though we love to go any time of the year, we especially like the winter season when cassoulet is the main dish every Wednesday.

Cassoulets are made with white beans, duck or goose confit and sausages, a delicious winter stew.

It is the signature dish of Toulouse but honest opinion: no one does it better than le Bistrot du Paradou.

The cassoulet is served family style accompanied by a fresh green salad.

Bottles of their excellent red house wine, a Côte du Rhône from Châteauneuf-du-Pape (Mont Redon) are in arm's reach and are also replaced at any time.

When plates are cleared, their famous cheese platter arrives, almost a meal by itself. Who can resist?

We're not done yet. The dessert menu is another story in itself with most of the usual suspects and maybe a surprise or two.

Finally, coffee to end the meal, all included in the fixed price (pastis and bottled water are extras)

This is not an event for anyone in search of a quick meal. It is an experience, to be savored at a table of friends who would have probably already cleared their agenda for the day before arriving for lunch.

We have reserved a table for 12, indoors. The fixed price for this all inclusive lunch is €70 per person payable by credit card or cash at the restaurant.
