David is a Canadian who despite his advanced academic degrees decided at an early age that he wanted to work for the rest of his life with his hands. He does restorative work in stone, creates his own art and gives classes in stonecutting.



Nicole is French and a psychotherapist and her husband Mark is an American who worked abroad many years for WHO.

During the time they lived in Indonesia, Nicole became interested in reimagining dolls dressed in traditional clothing, which she discarded, then replaced their clothes with her own fashion inventions, mixing natural elements like plant material with a variety beautiful elements like silk, lace, feathers, etc.

Each has a “back story” explained by Nicole as she shows them to you.
